CEJN AB in Sweden do declare, to the best of our knowledge, that the products we provide meet all the regulations stated in REACH (EG 1907/2006), which includes the restrictions on substances listed in the appendix XIV and in appendix XVII. Of course, future products will be developed to meet the requirements according to this and future regulations.

However, in the decision ED/61/2018, ECHA (European Chemicals Agency), added lead, (Pb), to the REACH candidate list. This requires us to inform that lead is exceeding 0,1% in brass {3%}, aluminium {0,4%} and machine steel metal parts {0,3%}. Since most of our products do contain components of these alloys – all CEJN products should be regarded as containing lead above 0,1% unless we have stated otherwise.

Ingestion and inhalation are the main routes for lead to enter the human body. Permeation of the skin is minimal, especially when the substance is contained in a metal matrix/alloy. CEJN products are not intended for prolonged human contact and therefore our understanding is that they are not harmful.

Discarded products should be re-melted at smelters with adequate equipment for handling alloys containing lead.
